Mission Solar Energy LLC (“Mission Solar”) has reviewed the Residential Clean Energy Credit requirements under Internal Revenue Code §25D. Because solar modules produced by Mission Solar (the “Modules”) use solar energy to generate electricity, it is our understanding the Modules qualify as “solar electric property” under §25D(d)(2) of the Residential Clean Energy Credit when installed in a dwelling unit located in the United States that is used as a residence by the taxpayer.
