## MANUFACTURER'S CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

### For Residential Energy Efficient Properties Purchases

Under Title 26 – Internal Revenue Code § 25D, Residential Energy Efficient Property, the IRS allows up to a 30% federal Investment Tax Credit (ITC) for installing residential Energy Efficient Property as a “qualified solar electric property expenditure.” A “qualified solar electric property expenditure” is an expenditure for property which uses solar energy to generate electricity in a qualified dwelling unit located in the United States and used as a residence by the taxpayer.
